

Oasis High School Dress Code

A. General Expectations

- 1) No extremely tight-fitting or otherwise immodest clothing is permitted for either boys or girls.
- 2) Students may only wear APPROVED sweaters, sweatshirts, jackets or pullovers to school in cold weather. These must be of a solid color, with minimal sized logos or school logos.
- 3) Hats are not to be worn during the school day with the exception of outdoor PE classes. Violation of this rule will result in confiscation of the hat.
- 4) Any clothing that is ripped, torn or frayed in any manner is unacceptable.
- 5) With the exception of earrings, body piercing jewelry is not acceptable.
- 6) Jeans may be worn only on those Fridays announced by administration.
- 7) Any dress or appearance constituting a disruption or distraction of the educational process will be considered improper.
- 8) Any student representing Oasis High School (i.e. members of a team or activity, students participating on a field trip, etc.) may be required to adhere to a more rigid and specific guideline. The teacher, coach, or advisor, together with the principal, may establish their guidelines.
- 9) Students' dress must at all times be in accordance with all school policies concerning health, safety and academic atmosphere. Appearance must be neat, clean, and must not cause distraction or disruption.

B. Dress Code for Young Men

- 1) Shirts: School logo shirts must be worn.
- 2) Shorts: Relaxed-fit or regular black, navy, or khaki shorts in both flat and pleated fronts may be worn. Shorts must fit properly and must extend to fingertip length. They may not be too baggy, too tight, and may not sag. Shorts must be worn at the waistline. Cargo shorts are NOT permitted. Pockets cannot have zippers.
- 3) Pants: Relaxed-fit or regular black, navy, or khaki pants may be worn. Excessively baggy pants, tight fitting slacks, or slacks with drawstring waists are not acceptable. Cargo pants, corduroys, jeans, and jeans-like material are NOT acceptable.
- 4) Shoes: Dress shoes, leather deck shoes, leather loafers, or athletic shoes are acceptable. Sandals, boots, soft-soled moccasins, and Crocs are not acceptable.
- 5) Hair should be clean, groomed, well trimmed and moderate in style. No extremes in hairstyles, length or color are acceptable.
- 6) Business dress: (on specified days only – see calendar) Buttoned, collared shirt with tie, dress slacks, dress shoes. Jacket is optional.

C. Dress Code for Young Women

- 1) Shirts: School logo shirts and blouses must be worn.
- 2) Shorts: Only black, navy, or khaki Bermuda-style shorts or skorts (fingertip length) will be permitted. Cargo shorts are NOT permitted. Pockets cannot have zippers.
- 3) Skirts: Only black, navy, or khaki skirts - must not be shorter than fingertip length.
- 4) Pants: black, navy, or khaki pants may be worn. Capri pants (Black or khaki) are also acceptable. Stretch pants, jeans, jeans-like material, corduroys, excessively tight pants, pants made of spandex, and cargo pants are NOT acceptable.
- 5) Shoes: Flats, loafers, deck shoes, and athletic shoes are acceptable. Shoes must have closed toes and a closed back. 1" – 2" heels are permitted with western business attire. Sandals of any kind, boots, soft-soled moccasins, slip-on shoes, and Crocs are not acceptable.
- 6) Hair should be clean, groomed, well trimmed and moderate in style. No extremes in hairstyles, length or color are acceptable.
- 7) Business dress: (on specified days only – see calendar) Western business style or buttoned blouse, dress slacks, skirts, heels (see above – shoes).
